Dear Augustine House Community,

It is September already and Canada has an election around the corner. As with past elections Augustine House will have a polling station from 9 am to 5 pm on-site to facilitate Resident voting. Our Poll will be located in the multipurpose room. A reminder to Residents: please bring the appropriate ID.

The Provincial Vaccination Card is now in circulation. Augustine House realizes that a number of Residents do not have access to a computer or Smart Phone. For this reason, we will have a staff member available on Wednesday, September 15 and Thursday, September 16 to assist in this process. To expedite this process, we ask that Residents bring their Care Card or Provincial Health Number and their proof of vaccination card if they have it. We will provide them with a print-out of the Provincial Vaccination Card for their records.

The Provincial rules around visiting remain the same as before. Visitors must be screened upon arrival and wear a mask in common areas at all times. If a visitor is fully vaccinated they may take their mask off in the Resident suite. However, based on the virility of the Delta Variant, we are asking visitors to continue to wear their mask even when in a suite unless eating or drinking. We are also asking that visitors make an appointment whenever possible so we can ensure there will be a staff member available to organize the required screening. This is particularly important if a visit is scheduled for an evening. We have consolidated our screening information and sheets at the main entrance and ask that all visitors enter through this doorway.
